PARISH ACTIVITIES THIS WEEK

Palm Sunday, Holy Week Masses and Liturgies will be celebrated in private by the priests. Fr. Peter has worked very hard to set up live streaming using Youtube. We ask that you be respectful and honor the **Diocese's Directive that the faithful not be present in the church during the Mass.** We will be live streaming the following Masses:



Daily Masses at 8:15am
Palm Sunday Mass at 8:00am
Holy Thursday Mass of the Lord's Supper - 7:00pm
Good Friday Liturgy at 7:30pm
Holy Saturday at 8:00pm
Easter Sunday Mass at 8:00am

To be able to participate in these Masses from home, you can go to the parish website, www.stwill.net. Close out the purple banner at the top by clicking on the tiny white 'X' on the upper right on the banner. Click on the Parish Life tab. Click on the Live Streaming tab. Click on the link to the **StWilliamonSSI** channel on **Youtube**. You may click on the Mass that is currently livestreaming, or any of the other Masses that are available to watch.

At present, there are **NO PUBLIC MASSES** celebrated in any parish churches or missions in the Diocese of Savannah, therefore **no one** is allowed in the church while the private Mass is being celebrated.

The church and chapel are open for private prayer and personal devotion, daily from 9am to 4pm. The **church** is limited to **10** parishioners at one time (per Diocese directive, County ordinance and CDC recommendations); the **chapel** is limited to **4**. A waiting line may form if necessary. We ask you to keep a distance of 6 feet between you and others and bring your own hand sanitizer and wipes.

Please continue to support our parish church through online giving on our website, by mail. We also now have donation boxes in the church and at the office for your convenience.

If there is a need for Reconciliation or Anointing of the Sick, Last Rites or if there is a death, call Fr. Peter at (985) 516-9088. Leave a message if he does not answer. He will get back to you as soon as possible. Updates will be posted on our website, stwill.net, in the weekly bulletin and emailed. If you have any questions, please call the church office and we will do our best to assist you, 638-2647.



STEWARDSHIP MOMENT

PALM SUNDAY - APRIL 5, 2020

Blessed is the one who comes in the name of the Lord!



We begin this Holy Week with the reading of the Lord's Passion from the Gospel of Matthew. It is fitting that during this week we intensely focus our minds and hearts on the steps of our Savior as He laid down His very life for us. But let us also examine the seemingly small acts of stewardship by some who encountered Jesus during this most eventful week.

One occurred when Jesus gave instructions about the room where He would celebrate the Passover. Jesus said, "Go into the city to a certain man and tell him..." "In your house I shall celebrate the Passover with my disciples." While we do not know this man's name, we do know he agreed to this request — he shared the material gift of his home and the gift of hospitality. Because of his good stewardship, his own home became the site of the institution of the Eucharist!

There was also Simon the Cyrenian, who offered the gift of his physical strength, helping the Lord to carry His Cross. Consider, too, the actions of Joseph of Arimathea — he generously shared a material gift of the tomb that was his, and he gave the gift of service to our Lord by giving Him a proper burial. Then there were the "two Marys" who gave Jesus the gift of their time. Keeping watch in tender vigil after His death, they "remained sitting there, facing the tomb."

Each of these were simple acts of good stewardship, yet God used them in mighty ways. God invites each of us, too, to cooperate with Him in small ways through the sharing of our time, talents and material gifts. Small gifts can become mighty deeds when placed in God's service.
