Port of Prince is where the violence is occurring. It is 5 hours north of Cote de Fer. The people in our twin parish are safe. The main impact on our twin parish is the disruption in receiving food, fuel and other necessary items. The gangs control the roads and don't always allow supplies to pass through. We have a secure process for getting the funds we raise to Father Islaire so when the roads are open he can get what is needed. Please help us reach our goal for educating the children in our 3 schools. \$80 will educate an elementary student for one year and \$130 will provide a scholarship to a high school student. 2ND SUNDAY OF EASTER - APRIL 7, 2024 **DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY**



On this second Sunday of Easter, we celebrate Divine Mercy Sunday. We celebrate this feast today since God's mercy was shared with us through the resurrection of Jesus. To put it simply, today, we are celebrating Jesus' merciful love for us and how we can partake in it.

No matter where we are on our journey as a disciple of Christ, we are all in need of God's merciful love.

There are countless times throughout our day when we miss the mark. To our dear Parishioners of St. William,

I would like to inform you that our pastor, Msgr. Christopher Schreck, will be taking a break from liturgical functions, effective immediately, so he may attend to his health. Our parish weekend Mass schedule will remain unchanged. The weekday morning Mass schedule will remain unchanged with the following exception: Wednesday through Saturday morning Masses will be replaced by communion services. The office will continue as usual to handle requests for the Sacraments and other pastoral needs.

The decision to allow Msgr. Schreck to step back from his duties for health reasons was a consensus reached between Monsignor and our Bishop Stephen D. Parkes. The bishop is working to support us and to that end we anticipate an additional priest will join us to assist the parish temporarily, in approximately two weeks.




