In our readings this week, Eldad, Medad, and the man driving out demons were all doing the work of God. They had been entrusted with a gift and used it to glorify the Lord. Joshua and John should have responded in joy and appreciation for another's gifts and tal-

We oftentimes look at another's strengths as our weakness whether it be in parish life, in the workforce, or even in our own fami-

Jesus is calling us to cut out those sinful thoughts and attitudes from our lives. The next time we witness someone being a good steward of God's gifts — rejoice! And continue to examine how you are using your gifts and talents to ensure you are being a good steward of what God has entrusted to you.

We do not want to end up like the rich in our Second Reading from St. James. They stored up their riches to the point where they withheld wages from their workers! Timote George is one of the two brains behind the Tree Currency Program which was implemented in our twin parish in July 2023. He has successfully led this unique farmer-oriented program in ten other communities in Haiti. We are truly blessed to have him serving our twin parish community!

After one year of implementation, the Tree Currency Program in Côtes-de-Fer has involved 550 farmers in our twin parish. They have raised 30,925 seedlings and planted 8,620 trees. Both men and women farmers have benefited from this initiative, receiving better quality seeds, hand tools, instruction, and goats.



Georges studied Natural Resources & Peace at the United Nations-mandated University for Peace in Costa Rica. Since 2008, his focus has been environmental rehabilitation, natural resource management and capacity building at the community level.
