EPIPHANY HOUSE BLESSING CHALKING KIT

A beautiful way to literally mark the Epiphany within our homes is the tradition of chalking of the doors. Above the lintel of the door in chalk the following is written: 20 + C + M + B + 25 The symbols represent the initials of the traditional names of the 3



Magi: Caspar, Melchior, and Balthazar. They also abbreviate the Latin words *Christus mansionem benedicat* meaning "May Christ bless the house." The plus sign symbolizes the Cross and the number at the front and back represents the year 2025. Our Confirmation class has put together, and Father has blessed, house blessing kits containing chalk and instructions that will be available in the narthex and in the parish hall at all the Epiphany Masses for our parishioners..

STEWARDSHIP MOMENT 4TH SUNDAY OF ADVENT - DECEMBER 22, 2024



Our Blessed Mother takes center stage on this fourth Sunday of Advent, and fittingly so, as we draw near to the celebration of her Son's birth. After our Lord Himself, Mary is our model and guide to a stewardship way of life.

Today's Gospel passage

from Luke describes Mary's actions immediately after her "yes" to the angel Gabriel's message. "Mary set out and traveled to the hill country in haste to a town of Judah... and greeted Elizabeth." Mary immediately begins to think of others before herself, setting out quickly to be with her cousin, modeling two of the pillars of stewardship - Hospitality and Service.

What warmth and humility the Mother of our Savior shows, traveling to Elizabeth to spend time with her, rejoicing with Elizabeth over her own incredible pregnancy, and assisting her in a time of need. And what joy this hospitality and service brings to


